Introducing the newest spirit addition to our Conservation Series ~ Paloma Preserve

JW Marriott San Antonio Hill Country Resort & Spa and Desert Door Texas Sotol have pollinated a partnership to serve a signature cocktail exclusive to the resort using Desert Door Texas Sotol's Pollinator spirit. The cocktail, Paloma Preserve, will be available on the menu across all of the resort's restaurant and bar outlets including 18 Oaks, Cibolo Moon, Crooked Branch, High Velocity, Rivertop and Replenish.

Desert Door Texas Sotol's Pollinator is a sotol spirit which is made from Texas sotol plants, similar in contrast to tequila and mezcal. Pollinator was created with mesquite, persimmon and honeysuckle, which are native plants that are pollinated by Texas bee species.

The Paloma Preserve cocktail will feature the Pollinator Sotol, grapefruit juice, lime juice, simple syrup, topped with soda and garnished with a lime wedge, and will be served in signature blue porcelain tumblers.

The partnership between JW Marriott San Antonio Hill Country Resort & Spa and Desert Door Texas Sotol was established from the organizations' common mission of the preservation of Texas bees. Both the Paloma Preserve and Hill Country Honey Blonde beer served on property are part of JW Marriott San Antonio Hill Country Resort & Spa's Conservation Series aimed to create a positive impact to the local community.
